The DLMs will be administered in the same time window as the PARCC assessments. Some students with IEPs may complete a portfolio assessment in lieu of the standardized Science assessment. Please contact the Director of Special Services for further information. Attainment of passing scores on the PARCC assessments is the preferred path to graduation for high school students. Other pathways, including PSAT/SAT scores, AccuPlacer and ASVAB results, MAY be used to fulfill the NJDOE requirements.
